# Why Private Registry?

1. Store private images – including proprietary information (passwords, license keys, etc.)
2. Don't rely on network resources availability
3. Get the images faster from local network

- Docker registry installed locally
- Artifactory

# Options for Docker registry as a service:

- DockerHub
- Quay.io, tutum, CoreOS, StackDock, etc, etc.
- Artifactory
